BREAKFAST IS BACK. Please join us Sundays at 9:00 a.m. for breakfast, fellowship and conversation.

SHROVE TUESDAY PANCAKE SUPPER. Mark your calendars for Tuesday, March 1st at 6 p.m. Come celebrate Shrove Tuesday at our annual pancake supper. There will be plenty of pancakes, sausage, and fresh fruit.

AN UPDATE ON WINE AT COMMUNION. The vestry has discerned that it is time to reintroduce wine in our Eucharistic sacrament. The worship committee has finalized the new way we will incorporate wine along with bread and still meet Diocesan guidelines to protect our parishioners from COVID-19. On February 20th, we will add wine to our Eucharistic sacrament. Here's how we'll approach it:

There will be a wine station and a water station. Bread will be distributed as before. Those wishing to take wine will proceed to the wine station and pick up a cup. The lay Eucharistic minister will pour the consecrated wine from a common cruet into the cup. The wine will be consumed where it is poured.

The communicant will then move to the water station where water will be poured into the cup and consumed as an oblation. The cup will be left at the water station. This will necessitate a one-way flow as follows.

1. Outside pews front to back on south side of the church.
2. Outside pews front to back on north side of church
3. Center pews back to front.

Flow will be center to receive bread, right to wine, and then water station continuing back around the south side aisle to your seat. Those with mobility issues will be served in their pew at the end.

GUARDIAN ANGEL MINISTRY. During the Lenten season, St. John's will participate in the time honored tradition of the Guardian Angel program. Praying adults will clothe our St. John's Youth in prayer over Lent. Praying begins Wednesday, March 2nd, and lasts until Palm Sunday, April 10th. Look to Tuesday Headlines for links to click on if you are an adult interested in praying for a young person OR if you're in middle or high school and would like to participate-- there's a link for you, too! Our young people are growing up in a changing world; they are charting their courses and making decisions that will affect the rest of their lives. They need all the love, support and encouragement that we as a church community can give. Those interested will need to submit the requested information no

later than Friday, February 25th. Adults can send anonymous notes and small trinkets to their assigned Youth throughout Lent, letting them know how special and how loved they truly are. Youth can feel the strong presence of our Lord and know they are His. The big reveal event is a dinner in Hauser Hall on Sunday, April 10th.
